We all know the frustration and difficulties associated with grounds suffering from deep, hard compaction. The challenge for any aerator is how it shatters this hard dry ground without damaging the playing surface turf.

Imagine one machine that can do it all, from golf course fairways and greens, to racetracks, highly compacted sportsgrounds or intensely managed prestige arenas. Turfco introduces the Earthquake; the preferred choice of sportsground, racetrack, golf course and contract professionals alike. Nothing else comes close.

Unlike deep tine aerators that cannot be used in these conditions due to machinery strength or lack of penetration, the Earthquake will shatter the hardest ground to maximum depth of 38cm and leave the ground immediately ready for play.

The Earthquake's unique aeration blades deeply slice whilst simultaneously laterally fracturing... all without damaging the turf. It is ideally used when the soils are hard and dry for maximum soil shattering power. The earthquake can also be used to assist water run off in poorly drained grounds or for root encroachment in golf course fairways.

Put simply, there is no better way to breathe new life into a tired playing surface.



The Earthquake introduces a new style of broad acre decompaction that virtually makes deep tine aeration and other means of turf moling and deep ripping obsolete.

This two minute test will instantly tell you how well aerated your playing surface is, and how this will affect both the life of your turf and the playability of the ground. Simply take a 25cm screwdriver and:

- 1) Walk onto your playing surface
- 2) With one hand push the screwdriver without excessive force into the surface until it stops
- 3) Measure the distance it went in
- 4) Compare the result against our soil health chart below:
